FROM SEA TO LAND

A number of years ago, while Jonas was in the capital city of the Philippines in preparation to become a sailor, an earthquake hit his hometown. Upon hearing about the destruction and devastation, he rushed back to help in rescue and recovery efforts.

In the meantime, our church body through LCMS World Relief as well as LWML sent funds to our sister church to aid the effort. When Jonas brought supplies that had been purchased with these funds to his home church families in desperate need, they often wept and hugged him. Their gratitude profoundly affected Jonas. "I was only a servant of God; He was providing for my people through me." Could he continue serving God's people in other ways? One of his friends was preparing to leave for the seminary in Baguio that month. "Come with me!" he urged him. Jonas changed course, from sailor to seminarian.

Now Jonas is in his last year of classes, eager looking forward to graduation this spring so that he may continue serving the church and its members with the eternal gifts of Word and Sacrament. It has been a privilege for Dan and Missionary Roger James to prepare him for this task. (Even this was made possible because of your support.)


